Return value	Description
total_space	available storage space in byte without considering current usage
used_space	currently used storage space in byte (attention: files from bin which are not deleted permanently will also add to this!)
structure	Directory structure of file storage. A directory is defined by a name and the contained files and sub directories. Files are defined by their name and uuid. Temporarily deleted files are shown in bin and not their original directory. Permanently deleted files will not be shown!
